
Useable with most subjects (e.g., history, biology, architecture)

Details:

- **Topic**: This is the topic that will be discussed throughout the time ripple map
- Time: moving from the innermost to outermost circle, each represents a particular block of time
- **Factors**: these are factors that influence the topic (e.g., geography, politics, economy, etc.)
- **Objects**: these are the items that students place on the time ripple map. Their placement is decided by the student (according to time period and factors), and then the accuracy of this placement is discussed by the class.
- Connectors: these are items that fall between factors or time periods that link factors/ time periods/items together. Connections should be emphasized for student understanding.
