Select a neighborhood to study as a group.

Using your canvas, add the following information:

1. A map of your neighborhood
2. The sociodemographics of your neighborhood. Include
 - a. Total Population
 - b. Population breakdown by ethnicity, gender, age
 - c. Median Income
 - d. Housing
 - e. Rates of food insecurity if available.
3. The politics of your neighborhood. Include:
 - a. Riding
 - b. Mayoral and other representation
 - c. Political parties
4. Major historical landmarks and transitions in your neighborhood
 - a. A brief history of boundaries and identity
 - b. Historical landmarks
5. The food system in your neighborhood. Add these sites to your map. Include:
 - a. Community gardens
 - b. Major grocery stores
 - c. Food waste program (if there is one)
 - d. Restaurants of interest
 - e. Food assets
6. FINALLY, Identify the top THREE issues, given the map, the sociodemographics, and the politics of your neighborhood, to a sustainable food system.

(NOTE: I will provide you with forms and a way to map the food system in your neighborhood).
