You are the nurse caring for Elisapie today. The Orthopedic surgeon has been consulted to review her case. He arrives at the patient's bedside and explains that the ulcers are too deep and that they have caused too much damage to save her foot and lower leg, he states "this is what happens when you don't follow your prescribed diet." He is concerned about infection spreading up her leg and states that her best option is to have the leg amputated. He produces a consent and asks her to sign the form. She does.

Identify the Problem?

Patient speaks Inuktitut, could not possibly have understood the doctor's explanation.

What is the legal issue?

Consent was not informed - language barrier, lack of information/alternative, no opportunity to ask questions or to weigh alternatives

What would you do?

Suggest that an interpreter be called in to explain the doctors words. Ensure that the patient has all the information concerning the procedure to make an informed decision. Advocacy - nurse has a responsibility to advocate on behalf of the patient to ensure that she has the information that she requires to make an informed decision
